

BAC's 2024 Spring Performance Notice

Performance Dates and Times

BAC's 2024 34th Annual Spring Performance will be held on **Saturday, May 4th at 12:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. at McCall Middle School Auditorium.**

All students up through Level 4 will perform in one show only. All other classes including all Tap, Contemporary, Pointe, Teen, and Intermediate classes will be performing in both shows. Please be sure you received the Performance Assignments Notice.

Performance Day Information

All Pre-School ballet students will perform in Act 1 only (about 1 hour). DURING INTERMISSION students dancing ONLY in the first half must be picked up after changing into their street clothes to go home, or sit with their families to watch the second half of the show.

- Students should arrive 45 minutes prior to the starting time of their performance,
- NO SOONER, PLEASE.
- Come in your regular street clothes, carrying your costumes. Put names in everything!
- NO ONE SHOULD COME DRESSED IN A COSTUME!!!
- Dancers should enter through the side driveway entrance of McCall (next to the church).
- Parents and guests may enter through the front lobby only.
- Young students may be accompanied by one parent or relative to their dressing area to help them get changed. Due to the open nature of our changing area, no males are allowed to enter the dressing area.
- After your child is changed into their costume, you may then leave them with the assigned backstage helpers and take your seat in the auditorium for the show.
- Students dancing ONLY in Act 2 (Jazz, Tap, Contemporary, and Teen classes) may arrive before intermission, approximately 45 minutes after the starting time of the show, and do not need to be there for the first half of the show.
- Absolutely NO FOOD or DRINK will be allowed in the DRESSING AREAS or AUDITORIUM.

***** EVERYONE MUST CHANGE OUT OF THEIR COSTUME BEFORE LEAVING THE CHANGING AREA, WHETHER YOU ARE ENTERING THE AUDITORIUM OR GOING HOME. THERE ARE NO COSTUMES ALLOWED IN THE LOBBY AT ANY TIME!**

STUDENTS MUST REMAIN BACKSTAGE WITH HELPERS FOR THE ENTIRE FIRST HALF OF THE SHOW AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE AUDITORIUM PRIOR TO INTERMISSION. PARENTS SHOULD PICK UP THEIR CHILD AT INTERMISSION AND NOT BEFORE! NO EXCEPTIONS. ***

Ticket Information

Admission will be Reserved Seating. Doors will open 30 minutes before the show (no sooner). Please advise your guests.

Please arrange to leave infants and toddlers at home for the performance to avoid any unnecessary disturbance to the dancers and especially to other guests. Everyone entering the auditorium must have a ticket, including young children.

Ticket Sales

Tickets for the performance will be:

- **\$25.00 if purchased in advance, and**
- **\$30.00 at the door**

There are two options for purchasing tickets. We will NOT be selling any tickets out of the BAC office. **All ticket sales are final and there are no refunds or exchanges.** There is no limit to the number of tickets you may purchase.

Ticket Options

1. Online Ticket Sales

Online ticket sales will be opened on **Monday, April 8th at 6:00 p.m.**

- Go to www.bacw.com to purchase your tickets and choose your Reserved Seats at your convenience.
- Pay by Credit Card only.
- Bring your Order Confirmation (printed or on phone) to the theater on the day of the show – no other tickets are needed.

2.) At the Door

- You may purchase tickets at the door on the day of the show. Cash or check only, no credit cards.
 - The ticket price at the door is \$30.00.
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Dress Rehearsal

- Dress Rehearsals are **MANDATORY** and will be held during the week prior to the show, **May 1st, 2nd, & 3rd at McCall Middle School.**
 - Please be sure to view the Dress Rehearsal Schedule for specific dates and times for your child's class(es), or visit www.bacw.com to view and print the schedules.
 - **There are NO regular classes at the BAC studio Monday through Saturday, April 29th through May 4th during Dress Rehearsal week.**
 - Students should be accompanied by **ONE PARENT** who should change them and bring them into the auditorium to sit with their class. **Siblings and friends are not allowed at Dress Rehearsal.** Please make other arrangements to leave them at home.
 - There is no videotaping of dances at Dress Rehearsal. Parents will be given a designated time to be able to take pictures of their student while onstage.

A digital video of the entire show will be available for purchase through the studio at a reasonable cost. **Order forms are available at www.bacw.com.**

Hair and Make-Up

Please come to the performance with a

- **light foundation, pink blush,**
- **a pastel eye shadow (light blue, purple, pink) already applied.**
- **Bring a bright color lipstick with you (pinks work well - no purples, as they look blue on stage).**
- **Hair should be done at home the way each class has been instructed.**

Make-up for younger students should be applied moderately.

Backstage Helpers

BAC Moms, we need your help!

Each class participating in the Spring Performance must have 1-2 Mother Helpers to supervise backstage during the show. If you can volunteer to help out backstage, **please contact the office before the April 8th ticket sale date to sign up.** Mothers helping out do not need a ticket for the show that they will be backstage for, but will still be able to see their child's class perform. Please know that once tickets are purchased they are non-refundable, so please let us know before your ticket order is placed.
